Five Geographic Regions of Georgia Flipbook

Directions: Each region will be dedicated its own page within the flipbook. Booklets will be stapled upon completion to resemble a book. Each child will be given 3 sheets of paper in class to complete this activity. It will be graded on following teacher directions; all required elements are listed for each region, accuracy and neatness.

Your book must contain the following pages:

- Cover page. This will be a NEW, blank Georgia map that you will LABEL AND COLOR the FIVE regions.
- 2) Appalachian Plateau
- 3) Valley and Ridge
- 4) Blue Ridge Mountains
- 5) Piedmont
- Coastal Plain (the Barrier Islands should be included in the information of this region)

The following is the required pieces of information you are to include for EACH of the five regions:

- A) Location: Its relative location within the state of Georgia and how it is compared in size to the other regions.
- B) Physical features: Example) mountains? Hills? Plains? Etc...
- C) Specific physical features: What are some attractions that this location is known for? Think of tourist spots...
- D) Climate: When answering this, think about Georgia's overall climate.
- E) Natural Resources
- F) Land Use: farming, textiles...
- G) 1 interesting fact for each region that would attract someone to that area
- H) 1 to 2 pictures representing the region.
