

## “Mapping the Civil War”

**Georgia Performance Standards:** (SS8H6b) – The student will state the importance of key events of the Civil War to include Antietam, the Emancipation Proclamation, Gettysburg, Chickamauga, the Union blockade of Georgia’s coast, Sherman’s Atlanta Campaign, Sherman’s March to the Sea, and Andersonville.

### Materials Needed

- Blank outline map of U.S. (c.1860)
- Textbook/Notes
- Colored pencils

### Objectives:

Students will...

- Identify the geographic locations of the Confederate states (color grey), the Union states (color blue), the border states (color red)
- Label the Confederate States, Union States, and the Border States (pen or black pencil)
- Label the Confederate and Union capitals.
- Label important battle sites (including Fort Sumter, Antietam, Gettysburg, Chickamauga, Kennesaw Mtn, & Atlanta); Include the year of each battle!
- Label the Mississippi River and Atlantic Ocean.
- Use a black colored pencil to indicate Sherman’s March to the Sea (draw line and label the city he ended up in and year it happened) and the Anaconda Plan (draw a snake!).
